**Jr High Dance:** Friday, February 24<sup>th</sup>, Mrs. Bura is chairing. Permission slip will be going home Monday.

**Fish Fry:** First of the season of March 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday. Angela Talion and Kammy Shuman are chairing. Need new chairmen for next year and are looking for 2 or more people to shadow this year in preparation. Yvonne Chmielewski has shown interest, need additional people.
