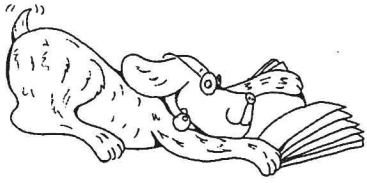
Requirements:



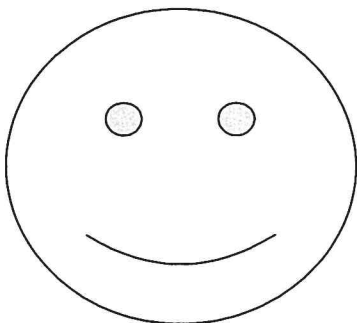
